

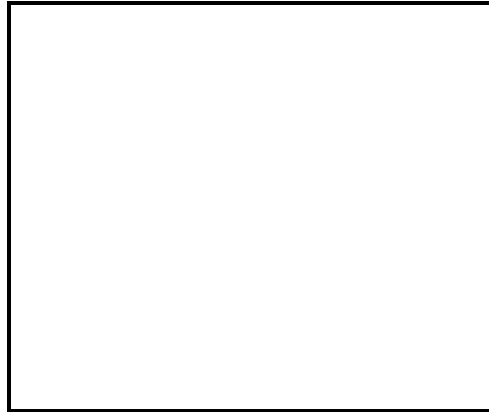
Don't be Afraid to Call the Police!

The Police Are Here To Help You!

Don't be Afraid to Call the Police!

If you have been the victim of a crime, don't be afraid to call the police for help.

The police are here to help you, and they cannot do their job without your help. The police cannot help you if you don't report crimes.



You Don't Have To Be Afraid

In some countries, police officers are corrupt or even violent.

In the U.S., the police are not allowed to accept money from you. It is illegal to offer a police officer a bribe in the U.S.



The Police Do Not Work For The INS!

Police officers are not immigration officials. They will not ask you about your papers if you call to report a crime.

What The Police Do

Police officers work to protect community residents, and to prevent crime.

Police officers patrol neighborhoods and respond to 911 emergency calls.



Call 911 To Report A Crime

If you have been the victim of a crime or know someone who has, call 911. You will not get into trouble for calling the police.
