As a result of an agreement signed with the Governor's Crime Commission, the North Carolina Crime Stoppers Association (NCCSA) will be coordinating this grant, and application for funding will be made directly to them. The Governor's Crime Commission (GCC) will review the recommendations of the NCCSA Board and will reimburse 100 percent of approved expenditures up to \$500 per school and up to a maximum of \$4,000 per school system.

First priority goes to those with no SCS program and/or who have never received funding, to existing programs with a demonstrated need, to regional campus collaborations if an appropriate letter of agreement is signed, and to local governmental entities where new programs require subsidization during the initial implementation process.

Applicants must submit documentary proof of their 501c3 status and Federal Tax Identification Number, and must conduct an annual reconciliation of their books as required by statute. All certifications must be received by the NCCSA before reimbursements are made. Failure to do so may result in funds being held or reverted entirely. No program may apply more than once for funding during this cycle

Applications must be received by the NCCSA **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 15, 2007.** The completed form and required documentation should be faxed or mailed to:

Approved applicants will be notified of their award amount soon thereafter. Award recipients must turn in all receipts to the NCCSA by **November 30, 2007. Receipts received after the 30th will not be reimbursed.**

Recipients will be required to participate in an evaluative statistical study at the conclusion of the grant cycle, so **please maintain separate statistics for your campus program.**

Funds may not be used for reward payments or for any purpose other than Scholastic Crime Stoppers. Promotional items must bear the telephone number and name of the SCS program. Computer hardware/software will only be considered for new programs, and funds may not be used for security enhancements or equipment; vehicle purchase or rental; entertainment expenses or luxury items; or indirect costs (such as administrative salaries).
